

6 appeared for Respondent Dean Logan.


7 Prior to the hearing, the Court issued a tentative ruling sustaining the Secretary's demurrer
8 with leave to amend. After hearing argument from counsel, the Court took the matter under
9 submission. The Court issued its final ruling, sustaining the Secretary's demurrer without leave
10 to amend on May 28, 2025, which is hereby incorporated into this judgment and a copy is
11 attached as **Exhibit A**.

12 **NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

- 13 1. The claims against the Secretary are dismissed with prejudice under Code of Civil
14 Procedure section 581, subdivision (f)(1).
15 2. Judgment is entered in favor of the Secretary and against Petitioners.
16 3. Petitioners shall take nothing from the Secretary by this action.
